What to Expect at the 2022 29er European Championship

The 2022 29er European Championship is approaching and the class and Royal Danish Yacht Club are excited to welcome the fleet to Rungsted! To assist your planning, we are providing information about the regatta and other logistical information, which we will update regularly. We urge sailors, coaches, and families to check this site frequently for updates.

EVENT STATUS:

The regatta is **ON!** We will hold the European Championship so long as the laws, regulations and public health protocols of the host country allow.

LOCAL INFORMATION:

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- We are going paperless! All entry documents, including declarations/liability waivers, will be completed electronically when sailors enter. We will not print these documents at registration, but they will be available for viewing online during registration.
- Membership in the International Class is **required** before entering the event. No exceptions will be made.
- Age requirements: **sailors must be 13 years old by 31st December 2022** to enter the championship. No exceptions will be made under any circumstances.

PRE-EVENT TRAINING:

The venue will be open for pre-event training from 20th to 26th June. Teams interested in training at the venue should contact Ann Marie Mohr at amm@kdy.dk.

RACE INFORMATION:

SUSTAINABILITY:

Royal Danish Yacht Club is committed to delivering a clean regatta in accordance with the standards set by Sailors for the Sea. Please join us in supporting our hosts in this important effort!

Sustainability initiatives for the 2022 European Championship will be updated regularly and we ask sailors, coaches, and supporters to check regularly for updates. As of March 2022, participants should plan for the following:

- Our regatta hosts will provide each sailor with a reusable water bottle. **No single use plastic water bottles will be permitted or supplied throughout the championship.** Water refill stations will be available throughout the boat park.
- We will be paperless to the greatest extent possible. Entry and declaration forms, as well all race documents, will be available online only.
- Flight colors will be distributed to sailors each day and collected for re-use at the end of each race day.
- Recycling bins will be available throughout the venue.

TRAVEL and COVID-RELATED ISSUES:

- We urge every sailor, competitor, and parent to monitor closely any travel rules and restrictions for entering Denmark from their home country and for returning home after the regatta. Understanding and complying with travel requirements is the responsibility of each person traveling.
